
STRIVING FOR EXCELLENCE




ONSET DAYS

The number of days from the time of diagnosis to entering rehabilitation The sooner rehabilitation begins, the better the outcome.




LENGTH OF STAY

The average number of days in rehabilitation.




PATIENTS SERVED BY DIAGNOSIS

Percentage of patients discharged directly home or to the community.






RETURN TO ACUTE CARE

Higher number of points reflects a greater level of independence.




AVERAGE HOURS OF THERAPY PER DAY
