
#### **Cancer Registry**

- Required by federal law (Public Law 102-515) and state law (Act No. 368, section 333.1101 to 333.25211) to report all cases of cancer.
- Required by Commission on Cancer Standards 5.1 to 5.7 to report incidence, treatment, and annual follow up of all patients diagnosed and/ or treated at Morey Cancer Center and McLaren Central Michigan to the National Cancer Data Base.
- Monitors all aspects of the cancer program for compliance
- with Commission on Cancer Standards, JCAHO Standards, and Medical Staff Bylaws.





#### **Comparison by Year of 1st Contact**




#### 2016 Cases by Gender








**Top 5 Sites for Males** 








#### **Top 5 Sites For Females**














#### **Stage at Diagnosis 2015**




**Best CS/AJCC Stage**
