- McLaren Oakland Children's Clinic: The Children's Clinic provides health care services for nearly 2,000 patient visits each year to uninsured and underinsured children free of charge.
- Sister & Sister Free Mammogram Program: The McLaren Oakland Foundation's Sister & Sister Free Mammogram Program provides nearly 1,000 free screening and diagnostic mammograms, each year to uninsured & under insured women.
- OsteoCHAMP Scholarships: The Foundation commits \$10,000 each year to provide disadvantaged Pontiac High School students with scholarships for Michigan State University's OsteoCHAMP Program, a two-week intensive residential summer program to encourage, prepare and foster the health career interests of high school students.
- McLaren Oakland Scholars Program: The McLaren Oakland Scholars Program provides in-class tutors, mentoring, career days and other programs to ensure that Pontiac students are academically prepared to take advantage of the free college tuition offered by the Pontiac Promise Zone.
- State-of-the-art Facilities, Technology and Equipment: The Foundation
 has purchased a state-of-the-art digital mammography system for
 the Sister & Sister Free Mammogram program and provided facility
 improvements to the Emergency Department and nursing units.
