September is prostate cancer awareness month. McLaren Oakland agrees with prostate cancer screening guidelines, established by the American Urological Association, which state that the PSA test is important in diagnosing prostate cancer at an early, more treatable stage in the course of the disease. Men are encouraged to talk with their health care provider to determine if screening for prostate cancer is right for them.

Health care professionals will be available to screen adult men for symptoms of prostate cancer and offer prostate-specific antigen (PSA) blood tests and rectal exams at no charge. Please register for one of the FREE events below to participate.

Eligibility requirements are:

- Between the ages of 50-75 (You are at higher risk if you are African American or have a family history of prostate cancer, and screening can start as early as 40 years of age)
- No personal history of prostate cancer
- Have NOT had a PSA within the last year
