Medicare will begin mailing new Medicare cards starting in April 2018. These cards will now have a unique Medicare number instead of using your social security number to protect your identity. Your Medicare coverage and benefits will not change. If you have a Medicare Advantage Plan like an HMO or PPO, your Medicare Advantage Plan ID card will remain your main card for Medicare. You will also be sent a new card, and may be asked to present both cards for verification. Cards will be mailed to the address on file with Medicare. If you need to update your address, please visit www.ssa.gov/ myaccount or call 1-800-772-1213. Please remember to update Marwood, as well as your doctors and other healthcare providers with your new ID number. If you have questions or are looking for more information please visit www.medicare.gov. Please note it may take several months to receive your card.
