She took a position as a registered nurse and in 1978, she and her children moved to their own home. Susan entered the University of Michigan and obtained a Bachelor of Science in Nursing Degree in 1988, graduating Magna Cum Laude. After graduation, Susan worked briefly for a local home care agency. She became self-employed in 1990 as a medical case manager. Susan returned to school and obtained a Degree of Master of Arts in Rehabilitation Counseling from Michigan State University in 1992. At that time, she received national certification as a Certified Rehabilitation Counselor. Susan now teaches at Mott Community College as an Adjunct Nursing Instructor.

- 7. The McLaren Flint Foundation will provide yearly reports, which include an accounting detail and biographical information about the scholarship recipient to the Rachor Family Foundation, Ltd. and the honoree or the family of the memorial honoree.
