# Identifying Stroke Symptoms

## B.E. F.A.S.T.

# B

### BALANCE

*Does the person have a sudden loss of balance?*

Trouble walking, dizzy, loss of balance or coordination.



# E

### EYES

*Has the person lost vision in one or both eyes?*

Sudden trouble seeing in one or both eyes.



# F

### FACE

*Does the person's face look uneven?*

Is their smile crooked or mouth drooping?



# A

### ARM

*Is one arm hanging down?*

Can the person raise both arms equally?



# S

### SPEECH

*Is the person's speech slurred?*

Is speech slurred, or drooling, or confused?



# T

### TERRIBLE HEADACHE AND TIME

Does the patient have a terrible headache? TIME IS CRITICAL.

*Activate Stroke Response or Rapid Response Code Stroke*



*Note: In some cases, stroke may also cause a severe nausea and vomiting of unknown cause.*
