1700 until 0000 <small>(6/2/18)</small>	6/1/18	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • CPOE no longer available, go to paper downtime. Any new admits will need to have all paper orders including a Med Rec completed. • Only 1 admission med rec (Paragon or Cerner) is required to be completed on the patient. Placing one in both is okay. • Room numbers and allergies are required all paper orders. Stickers must be on every page. • Still use Paragon for documenting assessments, care plans, Medication History.
2200	6/1/18	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • New armbands and stickers will begin arriving to unit(s) for inpatient patients only. • Do NOT remove Paragon armbands. If possible place Cerner armband on opposite arm. • All patient new and existing will need to add patients in Omnicell using manual "Add a Patient." All medications for new patients will be removed in override. (Directions on Omnicell)
2300	6/1/18	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Medications due to be given at midnight need to be administered in Paragon at 2300. Have completed before 2359 • Inpatient patient that starts in Paragon and will continue through Cerner will be stickered with CERNER stickers. All Paragon stickers will go away. • Outpatient patients that will not become inpatient will stay with Paragon through their discharge.
2359	6/1/18	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • NOTE: for any patient from the ED needing to go to the Operating Room between Friday to Saturday at 12:01AM <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -- If the patient was on paper in the ED, then when they go to the Operating Room-- they will stay on paper -- If the patient came into ED after midnight and was registered in Cerner, then they will be in Cerner for their OR case.

0001	6/2/18	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Start Cerner for all documentation, medication administration for inpatients. • Labs, radiology, pathology, etc. will result in: Cerner, radiology PACS will still be available for view • Continue with downtime/Paragon for any patients that are not inpatient or will be going home today • Associate patient to all monitors with Cerner wristband. • Associate: IV Pumps, Specialty Equipment (Space Labs, Fetal Monitors), Respiratory Specialty Equipment
