The goal of the Breast Surgical Oncology Fellowship is to provide fellows the ability to:

1. Advance knowledge and skills in the surgical and multidisciplinary management of breast cancer.
2. Participate and understand research and support for patients with breast disease.
3. Function as part of a multidisciplinary team.
4. Be prepared to transition to practice.
5. Confidently manage benign diseases of the breast

At the conclusion of the fellowship in Breast Surgical Oncology, the fellow should be able to provide comprehensive, state-of-the-art medical & surgical care to patients with breast diseases. This will include the abilities to investigate, diagnose, recommend appropriate treatment options, perform the operative procedures, and provide the pre-, peri-, and post-operative care. The fellow will be able to successfully lead a multidisciplinary breast cancer team in addition to becoming adept at enrolling patients in clinical trials.
