

David Bradley, RN Nursing Scholarship

This Scholarship was established by the Rachor Family Foundation, Ltd. in recognition of David Bradley, R.N. The purpose of the scholarship is to provide financial assistance to the non-traditional nursing student who also has the responsibilities of work, home and family. At 40 years of age, and after a successful 18 year career in retail management, David decided to return to college and realize his dream of becoming an emergency room nurse. Not only did he want to become a member of a respected health team, he also wanted to show his family that no matter how old you are, you can achieve any goal you set. David continued to work while attending classes full-time until graduating with honors in June of 1995 from the Mott Community College ADN Program. Two days later he accepted a position with Genesys Regional Medical Center, where he currently practices as a trauma nurse in the Emergency Department.

Scholarship Guidelines

1. Applicants must be enrolled at Mott Community College and be in good standing with the college.
2. Applicants must be enrolled in the Nursing Program with a minimum grade point average of 3.5.
3. Applicants must submit a one to two page paper outlining why they want to become a RN and the circumstances which have created their need for financial aid.
4. Applicants must be non-traditional students, defined as experiencing an interruption in studies for five or more years between high school and college.
5. The minimum award is \$1,500 for the academic year.
6. The award must be used by the student for tuition, books, supplies and/or equipment needed in connection with the Nursing Program.
7. Scholarships will be applied directly to the recipients' tuition accounts.
8. The McLaren Flint Foundation will provide yearly reports, which include an accounting detail and biographical information about the scholarship recipient to the Rachor Family Foundation, Ltd. and the honoree or the family of the memorial honoree.
