Scholarship Criteria

- ✦ The applicant must be a dependent of a McLaren Flint (Company 60), Full-time (2080 hrs.) or Part-time (1040 hrs.) employee as defined by Human Resources guidelines. Probationary employees' dependents are eligible.
- ✦ The applicant must have completed 24 credit hours post high school.
- ✦ The applicant must have a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or better.
- ✦ The applicant must be registered for classes at an accredited college or trade school.
- ✦ The application must be complete with recent unofficial transcript by July 8, 2022.

This is a one-time, non-renewable award. Random drawing for winners of the McLaren Employee Dependent Scholarship will take place on July 19, 2022.
