## Fantine Pemberton, RN Centennial Memorial Nursing Scholarship

Fantine Pemberton, R.N., the first superintendent at the Lapeer Street Hospital where she preceded Margaret McLaren. In 1919, Fantine Pemberton, R.N. was the President of the Michigan State League of Nursing Education and was a proponent in the promotion of education and status of nurses. Fantine was the embodiment of quality care and excellence in Nursing, at what is now McLaren Flint.

## Scholarship Guidelines

- 1. Scholarship awards are merit based, and applicants can be full-time or part-time students who have a cumulative 3.5 grade point.
- 2. Scholarship awards are based on financial need.
- 3. Applicants must submit a one to two-page paper outlining why they want to become a RN and the circumstances which have created their need for financial aid.
- 4. Applicants must be enrolled in a clinical, health care administration or other health-related program at the UM-Flint or Mott Community College.
- 5. Preference given to current employees of McLaren Flint who are pursuing a nursing education.
- 6. Preference given to single mothers.
- 7. Scholarship award must be used for tuition, books and/or supplies toward nursing career.
- 8. The McLaren Flint Foundation will provide yearly reports, which include an accounting detail and biographical information about the scholarship recipient to the donor.
