The electrophysiology (EP) program at the McLaren Greater Lansing Heart and Vascular Institute offers a wide range of EP services for your patients, including various ablations and device implantations. Led by Dr. Khalil Kanjwal, the EP lab performs zero fluoro ablations for AFib patients using ultrasound, which incorporates sound waves instead of radiation to create images of the heart.


