**2020 PCP Value Based Reimbursement (VBR) and
2020-2022 Patient Centered Medical Home (PCMH) Designations**

The BCBSM Value-Based Reimbursement (VBR) program offers additional revenue for initiatives such as: PCMH, Clinical Quality (CQI) performance, cost, and provider delivered care management (PDCM). This provides an opportunity to earn up to a **168%** of the BCBSM fee schedule. As of 2020, a practice **MUST** be **PCMH** designated for the physician to achieve additional VBR opportunities.

We are excited to share our first **6** physicians who have achieved a PDCM VBR. This is based on an individual physician's percentage of engaged patients with 2 outreaches for care management services on 2 different dates of service. The benefits of PDCM include improvement in patient outcomes, patient experience, and utilization across all settings. The VBR effective period is September 1, 2020– August 31, 2021.
