

Semi-Urgent:

Needs Medical Care and can wait a few hours.

- Accidents and Falls
- Moderate Sprains
- Moderate Backaches
- Mild Breathing Difficulty (i.e. Asthma)
- Minor Cuts with Controlled Bleeding
- Eve
- Irritation/Redness
- Cold/Flu Symptoms WITH fever
- Vomiting/Diarrhea with Dehydration
- Severe Sore Throat or Cough
- Minor Broken Bones or Fractures (fingers/toes)
- Skin Rashes and Infections
- Urinary Tract Infections
- Minor Injuries
- Minor Burns

Urgent:

You should go to your nearest Hospital Emergency Department

- Severe Chest Pain or Difficulty Breathing
- Compound Fracture (bone protrudes through skin)
- Convulsions/Seizures
- Loss of Consciousness
- Fever in Newborn (less than 3 months old)
- Heavy, Uncontrollable
 Bleeding
- Deep Knife or Gunshot Wounds
- Moderate to Severe Burns
- Poisoning
- Serious Head/Neck or Back Injury
- Pregnancy-Related Problems
- Severe Abdominal Pain
- Signs of Heart Attack (chest pain lasting longer than 2 minutes)
- Signs of Stroke (loss of vision, sudden numbness, weakness, slurred speech or confusion)
- Suicidal or Homicidal Thoughts/Feelings
- Vomiting up Blood

If your provider does not offer Telehealth visits, consider using the <u>McLaren Now App</u> mclaren.org/mclarennow

When in doubt, patients who feel their symptoms require immediate medical attention may choose to go to a hospital emergency department, where medical professionals can determine which level of care is required.
