Further, the **PARTICIPANT** agrees that it has inspected the area in which the Event is the subject of this Hold Harmless Agreement will occur and accepts it as suitable for its intended use, and agrees that it will use the area at its sole risk.

Walking at Macomb Mall is a privilege, not a right. The following rules are intended to make the time you spend walking at Macomb Mall a more pleasant and safe experience. Macomb Mall reserves the right to limit access to the mall for walking should conditions warrant. Macomb Mall may also suspend the walking program in its entirety, and/or rescind an individual walker's privileges at any time.

- 1) Doors
  - a. During the holiday season mall opening hours and mall walking hours may be adjusted. For the balance of the year the Beaconsfield (mall office entrance) will open at 8:00 am Monday through Saturday. There is no early mall walking on Sunday.
  - b. Mall doors will be opened at approximately 8:00 am Monday through Saturday with the exception of the above mentioned door. All mall doors will open at 11:00 am on Sunday. Please do not unlock or exit any locked door.
  - c. Doors are only to be opened by Security personnel. This is to limit access to registered mall walkers only.
  - d. The mall will make every effort to notify walkers of any change to the walking hours in a timely manner; however we are not required to do so.
  - e. During times of inclement weather please call 586-293-7800 or 586-296-0330 (listen to the full recording) to find out if the mall is closed or there will be a delayed opening. You may also check our website at <u>www.shopmacombmall.com</u>; click on "Weather Conditions Update" under the Upcoming Events tab.
- 2) Employees
  - a. Please be courteous to employees and contractors working in the mall. They are working to improve and maintain the character and a safe environment in the mall. Do not pass through, move barricades, or enter closed/construction areas of the mall. Avoid all equipment in use in the mall.
- 3) Coats and Jackets
  - a. Use Coat racks provided, do not place coats/jackets on the planters, RMU's and kiosks. Any coats/jackets left in the mall after the mall opens (10:00 am) will be taken to Security. **The mall is not responsible for personal items that are lost or damaged.**
- 4) Walker Identification
  - a. For emergency reasons, walkers must CARRY identification at all times.
