## Examples of Specific Programs to support:

The Area of Greatest Need: As we like to say, gifts to the unrestricted fund are two gifts in one; they provide both the funding and flexibility to quickly address newly identified needs.

Cancer Services: In partnership with Karmanos Cancer Institute, McLaren Northern Michigan offers cancer diagnostic, treatment and recovery.

- General Cancer Services: Donations support equipment upgrades, programs, support groups, education for patients and colleagues, and patient assistance.
- Kathleen Jontz Breast Health Fund: Provides life-saving mammograms, biopsies, and follow-up ultrasounds to breast health patients in northern Michigan who are unable to afford them.
- Kim Monthei Breast Cancer Fund: This fund was established in memory of Kim Monthei by Kim's family and M&M Plumbing Heating/Cooling Inc. to provide breast cancer services for underinsured residents of Cheboygan County.

Cardiac Services: McLaren Northern Michigan is ranked one of the nation's 50 top heart hospitals by IBM Watson Health. Donations to Cardiac Services support purchases of life-saving equipment, colleague education, and emerging cardiac services.

Patient Assistance: Many times members in our northern Michigan communities are making a choice between buying groceries or their medications – or even forgoing procedures and testing because they cannot afford the gas to make the trip. Patient Assistance funds help offset "non-reimbursable" costs patients incur while seeking diagnosis or treatment such as gas cards, food supplements, lodging for visits to specialists downstate, minor medical equipment, medications, and so much more.
