The fund, named after local CPA and philanthropist Donna Niester, provides crucial assistance to uninsured women so they can receive mammograms, biopsies, treatment, and breast prosthetics. The fund also provides education for breast cancer awareness, as well as needed support for those undergoing treatment such as free wigs, hats, and medical supplies.

According the Kelly DiNardo, RN, BSN, Community Outreach and Education Coordinator, "This is our 14th year of celebrating survivors, and we decided to expand the celebration to include more of the community. When people join in survival celebration, they see how the fund impacts local women and see how important the Donna Niester Breast Cancer Fund is."

Over the last eight years, the fund has helped nearly 250 women receive free screenings and breast health care. Donna Niester has been a tireless champion for this cause since the beginning.

"I didn't want to look back one day and wish I'd done something, when I am more than capable today to make a difference in so many women's lives," says Donna. "I know many amazing women who now have or are survivors of breast cancer and have met so many more through my fundraising efforts. I wanted to know that I did all that I could to help the women of our community."
