To help improve patient safety, and to stay up to date with the most current technology, Marwood has invested in new specialty patient stands and lifts, electric shower chairs, automated vital sign machines, and a state-of-the art AccVein vein finder device.

Quality measures are tools that help measure processes, outcomes, patient perceptions, and organizational structure that are associated with the ability to provide high-quality health care or that relate to one or more quality goals.
