Ambulatory: Quest Lab Orders and Result Changes

Quest Lab Interface Overview

Workflow Change: The Quest Lab Orders and Results Interface connected to Cerner One McLaren will be decommissioned. Printed requisitions will be required for the patient and Quest lab results will be faxed from Quest to the clinic after the interface removal. Please see the grid below for timeline and event details.

Tentative Dates	Event
Fri, August 12 th	 Quest Lab orders (those with a "Q" prefix) will no longer be available to order in Cerner. Providers will use MLab Orders and change the Order Routing To field to "Patient Choice". Print the requisition and provide to the patient for these orders moving forward.
Mon, August 15 th – Fri, August 26 th	 Quest results will be auto faxed to clinics. Interface for Quest results will remain in place as a safeguard during this 2-week window. Clinics to verify they are receiving faxed Quest results during this time. An EMR Trainer, IT Support Staff, or Solution Lead will be contacting each clinic to verify faxes are being received.
Mon, August 29 th	 Quest interface will be turned off, barring no issues with faxed results. Results will only come in via fax moving forward. Staff and providers to follow the scanning workflow for filing and verifying results.
