<<Update to BRIDGE Blood Administration for Anesthesia>>

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Update to BRIDGE for Anesthesia

We recently discovered that total volume was not prompting for Anesthesia during BRIDGE blood administration. This field should appear when transfusions are ended to document how much blood was administered and will flow to the I&O of the patient's chart. This workflow is also part of the Blood Administration Simulations for Anesthesia.

We will be correcting this issue on 10/6

When we reviewed charts, we noticed that total volume was missing in most cases, however, a few times we noticed that it was documented under whole blood in the anesthesia record. After this change is made, do **NOT** document it in both places—you can still enter blood administration and volume as a free-text note in SaAnesthesia, however, the volume for any blood bank product should only be recorded once as part of BRIDGE and not under Intake in the Anesthesia Record (we do not want to double document volume in the patient's chart).

Remember—non-blood bank products should still be documented as Intake for in the appropriate type of intake in SaAnesthesia (i.e., Pump Blood Reinfusion or Cell Saver Reinfusion). All Output should be documented in Output.
