
Appropriate Use Criteria Radiology Studies

On November 2, 2023, the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) issued a final rule that announces finalized policy changes under the Physician Fee Schedule (PFS), effective on or after January 1, 2024.

CMS is finalizing the proposal to <u>pause efforts to implement the Appropriate Use Criteria (AUC) program</u>. <u>CMS is rescinding the current AUC program regulations</u> at 42 CFR 414.94. CMS will continue efforts to identify a workable implementation approach, and any such approach would be proposed through subsequent rulemaking. https://www.cms.gov/newsroom/fact-sheets/calendar-year-cy-2024-medicare-physician-fee-schedule-final-rule
