Ambulatory: In-Office Eye Irrigation Task

Eye Irrigation Task Overview

Enhancement: When a Provider places an order for Eye Irrigation to be performed in-office, a task will fire to the Task List to notify clinical staff.

Prior to this enhancement, a task did not fire to the Task List to notify staff.

Position Impacted: Ambulatory Clinic Staff using the Single Patient/Multi-Patient Task List.

Eye Irrigation Task – Clinical Staff Workflow

- 1). When the provider places an order for the patient to have an eye irrigation in the office, a task will fire to the **Single-Patient** or **Multi-Patient Task List** to notify clinical staff:
 - a. From the Task List, select the Office/Clinic Task tab.
- 2). Once the Eye Irrigation is complete, clinical staff can complete the task from the Task List by single-clicking the **Yellow Box** next to the task.
 - <u>Note</u>: There is no form associated with this task, the task is for notification purposes only.
