


Some Bedside Glucometers are currently not uploading glucometer results into Cerner.

Until this is resolved, the workaround will be to manually enter the results into iView using the following steps:

- 1. Open Interactive View and I&O
- 2. Select Vital Signs
- 3. May need to customize view and pull Glucometer Downtime, POC on view.



- 4. Input the Blood Glucose result from the Glucometer into the 'Glucose Downtime, POC' field.
- 5. Change date and time if needed to reflect actual time glucose was obtained.
