
Accessing Your McLaren Now+Clinic Health Record

Thank you for visiting McLaren Now+Clinic. To access your health record or test results from your recent visit, please read and follow the instructions below.

1 Ensure you've provided a valid email address to the Now+Clinic nurse upon registration/checkout.


2 Following your visit, you will receive an email invitation to register and access your portal account from **HFAalerts@nextgen.com**.*

You must click the link and follow the instructions in the email within 5 days or the link will expire. We apologize if this process causes inconvenience, but it is an important part of ensuring your data security and confidentiality.

3 After clicking the link to begin the registration process, activate your account by providing your date of birth.



4 Once you've submitted your date of birth, you'll be prompted to create a username, password, and additional information.

Remember what you've submitted for your username and password, as you will require it in the next step.
