Changes to Operative, Procedure, and Immediate Post-Op Note Templates One McLaren Sites

Beginning 9/12/2023, significant changes will be made to the operative report, procedure note, and immediate post-op note Dyn Doc templates within Cerner. This will align the notes with regulatory standards. Providers may notice that fields within these notes have been modified slightly. Most notably, the header for "Drains" is being removed from the Operative Report and the Immediate Post Op note templates. Any drain insertion can be recorded in the Procedure Details section.

The most significant changes can be seen in the Procedure Note. See image below for changes.
