Orders Requiring Diagnosis

Starting 8/22/2019, the following orders will require Diagnosis when ordering on Clinic Encounters/Accounts. The change is so that charges post appropriately and correctly to the claim and are able to accurately and efficiently submitted to payers.

Effected Orders:

1. Surgical Professional Fees
2. Diagnostic Professional Fees
3. EKG
4. Office Level Global Professional Fees

When placing these orders, physicians will now find a blue required “X” over the Diagnosis tab.

1. Click on the Tab
2. Click on Add to add Diagnosis
