Update Quick Orders Pages For Hospitalist and Internal Med

Currently, according to the Providers, the design of the specialty-specific quick orders pages, is not up to date for the needs of the organization in both the outpatient space and the inpatient space.

Cerner will be updating the quick orders pages with the recommendations and designs identified by specialty-providers. This should help increase ordering efficiency, reduce the number of clicks to order common orders, and increase charging efficiency.


