On 11/29/2023, the user level prioritization of the diagnoses and problem list (if set by one provider, it remained that way for that provider) will be reverted to the prior function of shared prioritization. (When the list is prioritized by one provider, it will show that way for all providers until it is reprioritized.)

The prior change enabling the user level functionality removed the automatic association of diagnoses. After extensive review with Cerner, these functions are tied together and cannot be separated at this time. There is a concern that this could impact revenue. While the possible impact is being evaluated, the organization has determined that the system will need to revert to shared diagnosis priority.
