
## **Ambulatory Medication & Immunization Changes**

**Change:** Effective, November 8, 2019- Ambulatory Medications (Vaccine and Non-Vaccine Meds) will have different options to select on the documentation task screen.

\*This change does not apply to Oncology clinics\*

## **Immunizations**

- 1. Each dropdown is now labeled per the vaccine being given.
- 2. Users will now see different choices in the **Vaccine Charge** and the **Vaccine Admin Charge** dropdowns, that apply specifically to the vaccine being given.
  - a. For Vaccine Admin Charge: If selecting the **Counseling Admin** codes, if the vaccines is a multicomponent vaccine, users will select the appropriate choice according to how many components are within the vaccine.



## **Medications**

- 1. Users will see less choices in the **Medication Charge** and **Med Admin Charge** dropdowns.
  - a. For example, if the med is a 150mg order, the only choice for the med will be 150mg, plus the option to indicate the patient supplied their own medication.



2. "Vial Size NA" field: The description of the field previously indicated "Option Not Available". This field is to be used if you have a vial/dosage that is not listed in the dropdown for selection. If so, enter it into this field.
