## CARD HEART AND VASCULAR POWERPLANS

### Three plans

**1. CARD Heart And Vascular Periprocedure Multiphased**

This set will be used for any cath lab procedures whether scheduled or emergent. In Lansing, we will not be using the Emergent Procedure Pre & Intraop Meds or the Planned Procedure Pre & Intraop Meds phases as these are still on paper at this site currently. (These phases cannot be hidden for Lansing.)

**2. CARD Heart And Vascular Admit and Post Procedure Orders**

This set will be used after the cath lab procedure to admit the patient, place the patient in observation status, or for extended recovery patients (people not going immediately home). This is for patients requiring a PSO (patient status order) and answering admission quality items.

**3. CARD Heart And Vascular Post Procedure Focus Orders**

This set is to be used for patients that were already in the hospital before going to the cath lab that already had an admission set done before the procedure. This is for patients not requiring a PSO who had quality items addressed with another admission order set.

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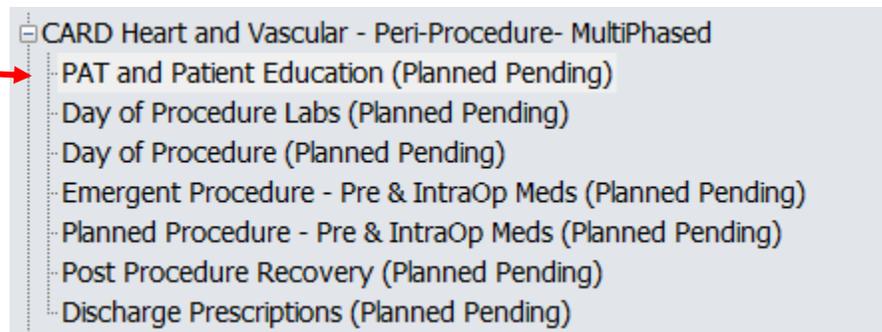
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## Steps for CARD Heart And Vascular Periprocedure Multiphased

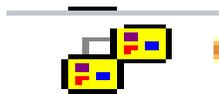
-Search and choose the set

 CARD Heart and Vascular - Peri-Procedure- MultiPhased

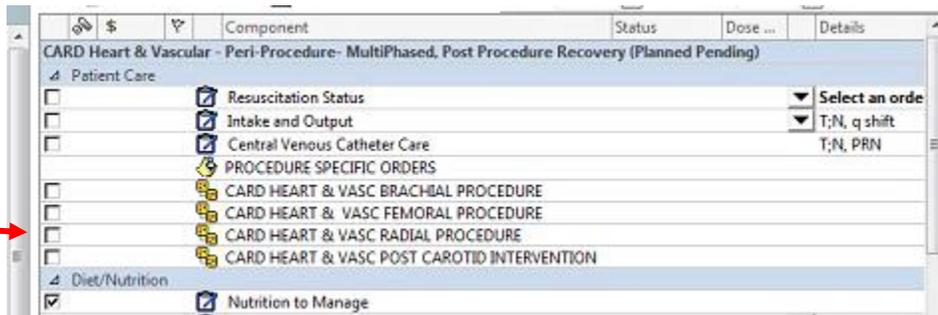
Start as defaulted or choose the individual phases of the plan. Choose each individual section in the gray view field, select your choices and then go back to the left fields in the view window to pick the next phase. For example, fill out the PAT and Patient Education and then the Day of Procedure Labs, etc. until you finish all the appropriate sections (we are not using the Pre & Intraop Meds phases in Lansing as that is on paper).



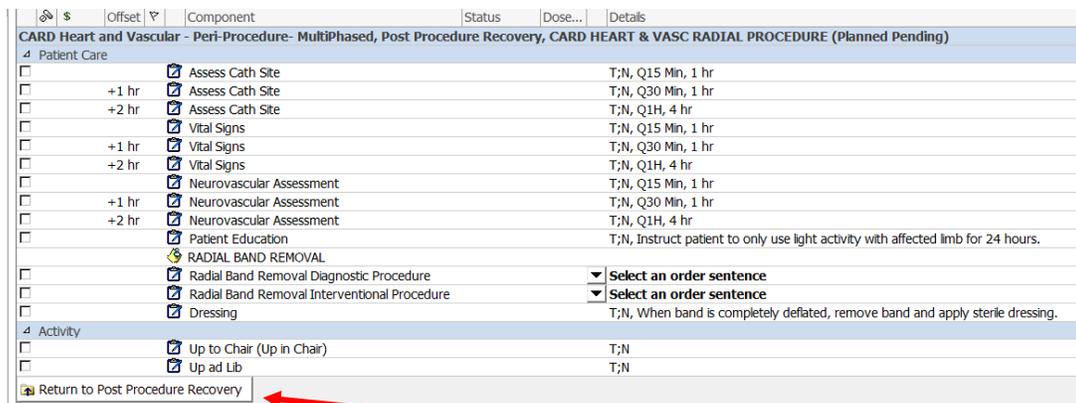
In the Post-Procedure phase you will see subphases to pick the post op orders specific to the procedure entry site (brachial, femoral, etc). These have a symbol that looks like two linked pizza boxes.



Click the box in front of the subphase of your choice.



This will open the orders in the subphase like this:



To return to the rest of the order set for completion choose the Return to Post Procedure Recovery button.

Please note that the Eliquis and Xarelto in the Post Procedure Recovery area are ONE TIME orders meant for the immediate post op areas.

The Activated Clotting Time (POC) is the order meant for the areas where there is a machine present in the area like Lansing Cath lab.

The Activated Clotting Time (M) is for the areas where the lab brings the device (like the PACU, inpatient, and observation units).



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## In the Discharge Prescriptions Phase:

This is meant for those leaving from an outpatient area or to be queued up for those to be discharged later.

**PLEASE NOTE: THE NURSES CANNOT INITIATE THIS PHASE AND GET THE PRESCRIPTIONS TO CROSS. DOCTORS HAVE TO SIGN AND INITIATE THIS PHASE WHEN APPROPRIATE.**

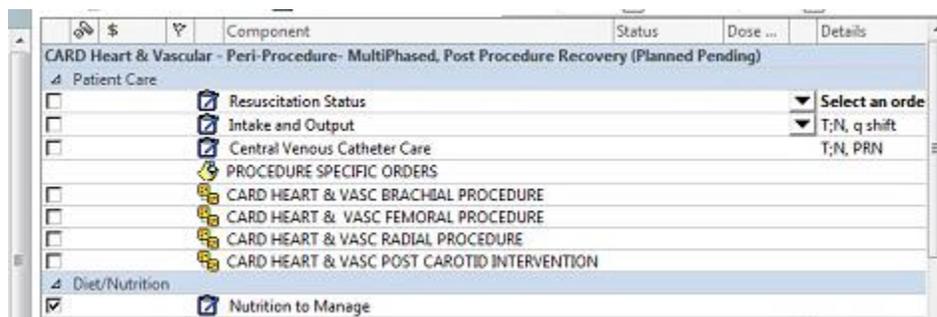
The physician or the nurse can initiate the phases other than the prescriptions.

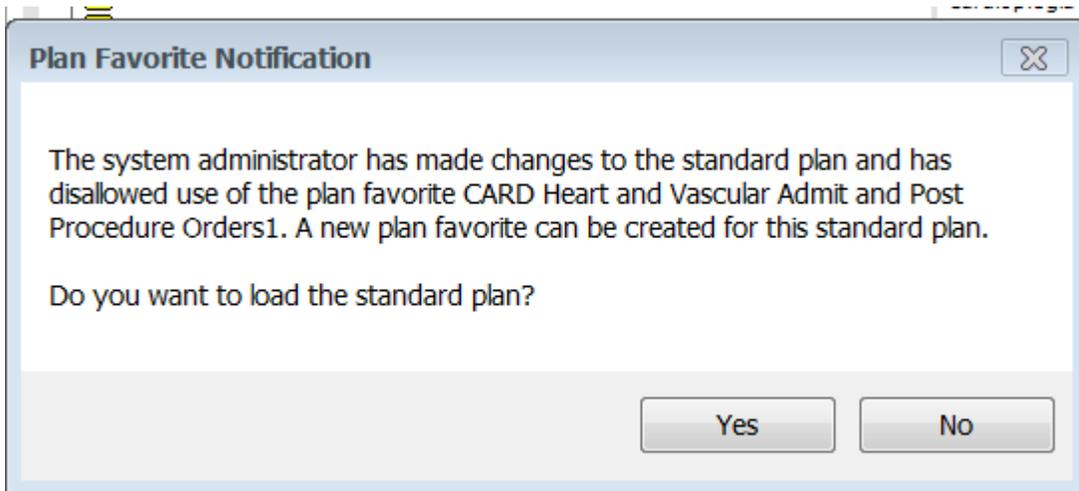

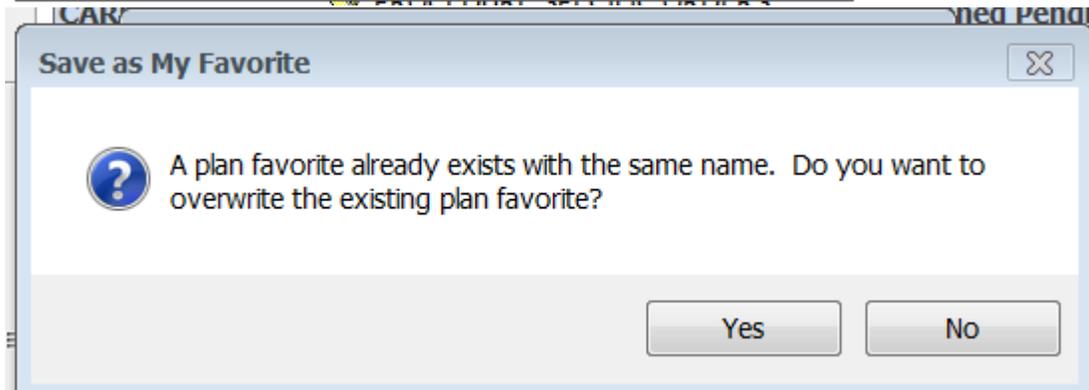
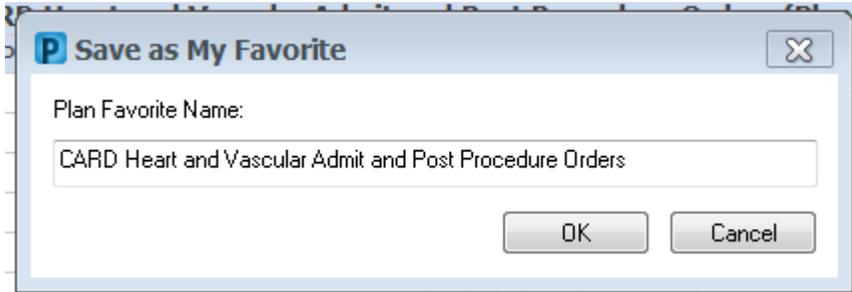
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You will see a screen like this one:



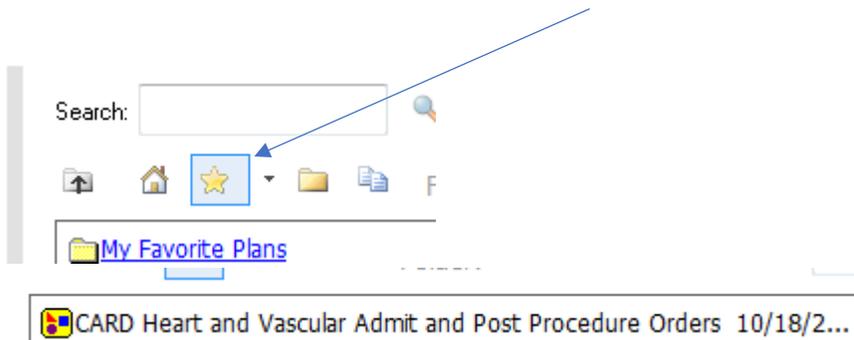
Click YES. (If you click no, you will see this screen until you click yes. You will not be able to use the old plan either way.)
