


Incentive Spirometry Task for Nursing

To increase use and documentation of Incentive Spirometry (IS) to promote better outcomes for our patients, a task for Incentive Spirometry has been associated to the Incentive Spirometry Nursing order. Note there are IS orders for Nursing and separate IS orders for RT, each send tasks to their respective area depending on who is managing.

The IS nursing tasks will display on CareCompass and Activities and Interventions. Scheduled tasks will be timed based on the frequency ordered and PRN tasks will show on the PRN tab of CareCompass. All tasks open to IS documentation in iView.





PowerPlans with RT to manage may have the nursing order tasked as PRN. PowerPlans with nursing to manage have the Incentive Spirometry Nursing order defaulted to task Q4 hours while awake. This is to promote documentation of the patient's use, effort and response. It does not change the recommendation to encourage independent patient use 10 times per hour while awake.

<u>Reminder</u>: The Incentive Spirometry Supply Charge for an IS device should only be documented Yes when the device is first supplied to the patient. If the IS is already at bedside you may chart No, or simply skip this documentation field.
