


## Patient's Own Medication Supply Workflow

When pharmacy is notified of a patient home supply being stored either on the unit or in the pharmacy, they will place an order indicating the location of the medication(s).





This will come across as a new order alert requiring nurse review. This will also display on the MAR in the **Unscheduled** category as further notification that patient supply is being used or stored.



Upon placement of a discharge order, a task will populate on CareCompass and on Activities and Interventions inside the chart. The task reminds the nurse to locate the patient's medication supply and send it home with them. This will help to ensure patients do not leave without their medications.
