The BRAvo for Women program improves access to health care and advanced technology in our community. Since 2010, BRAvo has provided more than 2,000 free mammograms, breast ultrasounds, and breast biopsies to Macomb County women. While we continue to offer the free mammogram program, healthcare reform has reduced the number of uninsured women. Our fund raising efforts are now focused on providing state-of-the-art technology for the early detection of breast cancer as well as other important women’s health initiatives. In 2018, BRAvo funds were used to purchase a 3D mammography unit, provide breast health education, and promote breast cancer awareness. Our 2019 goal is to raise funds to purchase another 3D unit for northern Macomb County.
