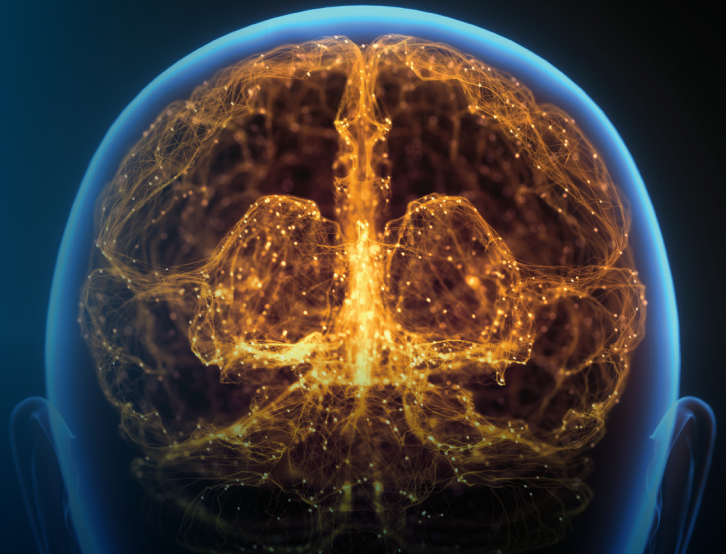

Multiple sclerosis is complicated because no two cases are exactly alike. Each person will differ in their symptoms, how often and severe their relapses are, and in the progression of their disease. As with many other chronic illnesses, early detection is key to minimizing the damage MS does to the body and keeping it at bay. Diagnosing MS cannot be done with one single test; a definitive diagnosis must meet strict requirements:

Clear clinical demyelinating event(s)

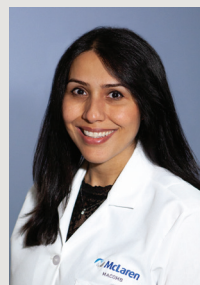
- Neurological evidence of lesions in at least two distinct areas of the central nervous system.
- Evidence that the lesions have occurred at different points in time.
- Other diseases that mimic MS must be ruled out.

CNS immune disorders occur when brain or spinal cord function is diminished or impaired, resulting in reduced motor, sensory, or cognitive performance.

This category of illnesses includes MS as well as:

- Neuromyelitis optical spectrum disorder
- MOG associated disorders
- Neurosarcoidosis
- Autoimmune and/or paraneoplastic encephalopathies
