Our physicians use various diagnostic tools, such as ultrasound, CT scans, and MRI scans to help diagnose and treat these conditions.

Treatment options may include medication, surgery (including minimally invasive robotic surgery), or other non-invasive procedures.

PROSTATE CANCER

Prostate cancer typically grows slowly and may not cause any symptoms in its early stages. However, as the cancer grows, it may begin to press against the urethra and cause symptoms such as difficulty urinating, frequent urination, blood in the urine, and pain in the back, hips, or pelvis. It's important to provide your patients with PSA testing and screening to ensure their prostate is healthy. If you have a patient that has an elevated PSA, refer them to our prostate clinic or one of our urologists for further evaluation.

URINARY INCONTINENCE AND BPH

Whether your patient is struggling with incontinence (going to the bathroom too frequently), or BPH (enlarged prostate gland affecting urinary flow) the urologists at McLaren Port Huron are here to help. Our experts can help diagnose your patient accurately and provide treatment options that may include medication, minimally invasive procedures, or surgery, depending on the severity of symptoms and other factors such as age and overall health.

Procedures and treatment options:

- Urolift for BPH
- Transurethral resection of the prostate (TURP) for BPH
- Male incontinence surgery
- Female incontinence surgery
- Therapy for incontinence

SCREENING

It's also important to schedule your patients for routine prostate exams as BPH and other conditions, such as prostate cancer, can have similar symptoms. Early detection and treatment of BPH can help prevent complications and improve quality of life.
