The electrophysiology (EP) program at McLaren Greater Lansing's Heart and Vascular Institute offers a wide range of EP services for your patients, focusing on diagnosing and treating abnormal heart rhythms, known as arrhythmias. The EP lab is equipped with the latest advanced technology, ensuring comprehensive care and the best treatment options available.

EP PROCEDURES

- Cardioversions
- · Diagnostic electrophysiologic studies
- Catheter ablation of supraventricular tachycardias, including Wolf-Parkinson-White Syndrome, AV nodal reentrant tachycardia, and atrial tachycardia
- Catheter ablation of atrial fibrillation (AFib) and atrial flutter
- Catheter ablation of complex ventricular arrhythmias, including PVCs and ventricular tachycardia
- Cardioneuroablation and autonomic modulation therapy

- Implantable electronic cardiac monitors
- · Traditional pacemaker implantation
- Leadless pacemaker implantation
- Conduction system pacing devices
- Implantable cardioverter defibrillator implantation; traditional and subcutaneous

- Cardiac contractility modulation (CCM therapy)
- · Heart failure implantable device therapies
- Pacemaker and implantable cardiac defibrillator testing
- Left atrial appendage occlusion device therapy (LAAO)
