Holidays and Special Events: assist the activities staff in setting up events or in transporting residents by wheelchair to and from special functions

Activities: Visit one-on-one with residents; provide companionship, play games or read the newspaper, magazines or books. Assist with activities program such as bingo, coffee hour, current events, etc.

Pet Therapy: Bring a suitable pet to visit residents. All visiting pets must have current shot/immunizations records.

Arts and Crafts: Participate in arts and crafts and assist residents in artistic group activities

Transport: Assist staff in transporting residents to and from select activities including rehabilitation therapy

Dining Services: Assist in the set up of meal service for residents or help residents complete weekly menu selections.
