Scholarship Guidelines

- 3. Applicants must be enrolled in the nursing program at Mott Community College or UM-Flint.
- 4. Preference given to high school graduates or GED recipients from Genesee, Shiawassee, or Lapeer counties.
- 5. Preference given to current employees of McLaren Flint or McLaren Bay Region who are pursuing nursing education.
- 6. Scholarship award must be used for tuition, books and/or supplies toward nursing career
- 7. The McLaren Flint Foundation will provide yearly reports, which include an accounting detail and biographical information about the scholarship recipient to the Rachor Family Foundation, Ltd. and the honoree or the family of the memorial honoree.
